

Job Posting: **Project Engineer for Water/Wastewater Service Company**

Position Overview: Work with in-house and outside professional consultants, operators and contractors to develop the water and wastewater utility infrastructure and management systems in a cohesive, efficient and economic manner. This is a full time position.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Develop and review reports for water production, treatment and distribution; wastewater collection and reclamation; and reclaimed water treatment, distribution and use.
- Manage and coordinate activities amongst consultants and contractors from project inception through completion with an emphasis on safety, timeliness, budget and regulatory compliance.
- Compile and submit permit applications and otherwise coordinate efforts with local land use and state regulatory agencies to gain necessary approvals and to foster a cooperative and professional working relationship.
- Work independently or as a project leader on studies assessing capital improvements and ongoing operation and maintenance procedures including both oral and written reports.
- Analyze survey reports, maps, and other data to plan projects
- Assist company management to prepare reports and presentations for customers, shareholders, and other stakeholders.
- Consider construction and operating costs, government regulations, potential environmental hazards, and other factors and risks during project planning.
- Help to recognize and resolve emerging problems, conflicts and deficiencies.
- Participate in conferences and meetings with water professional and trade groups, local planning agencies, and state compliance and regulatory officials.

Minimum Education and Experience

- Graduation from a four-year college or university with a major in engineering or related field.
- Four years' civil engineering experience with an emphasis on planning, design and implementation of water and domestic wastewater systems.
